## POSITION DETAILS

- One of CAP's biggest roles is helping people learn their HIV status with fast and free/inexpensive testing and advice on reducing risk.
- Perform rapid and confirmatory HIV tests.
- Conduct pre- and post-test counseling within county, state and federal laws.
- Participate in required trainings and continuing education.
- Deliver negative and positive test results, discussing risk behaviors, action steps, harm reduction, referrals and completing case report forms.
- Document tests in records and log books.
- Additional tasks, such as administrative support or file management, may be assigned during shifts.
- All candidates must submit a supplemental volunteer application and will be interviewed prior to placement.
- 50 hours of trainings, modules and observations required.
- Firm one year commitment.
- Shifts available (volunteers are expected to take two shifts per month):
  - Monday 5:15 – 7:45pm in Beaverton (12550 SW 2<sup>nd</sup> St.)
  - Tuesday 4:45 – 9:00pm at Pivot
  - Wednesday 12:15 – 4:00pm at Pivot
