POSITION DETAILS

- The Community Advisory Board (CAB) has three primary objectives:
 - 1) to share feedback about program development and ongoing operations from people who use CAP services or represent communities CAP serves
 - 2) to provide leadership development opportunities for members
 - 3) to develop an advocacy body which can represent CAP in the community
- Some tasks of this role are: reviewing policies and procedures; assessing services; assisting with data collection; reviewing CAP communications; identifying gaps in services.
- Attend and participate in CAB meetings (3rd Wednesday of every other month from noon to 2pm), and other activities as appropriate.
- Ideal candidates will: have knowledge of local and national HIV/AIDS issues; have understanding or lived experience of what it means to be HIV+; knowledge of CAP's services; have accessed CAP's prevention, education or support services.
- **Women and people of color strongly encouraged to join.**
- One-year commitment is required to serve on CAB.
